Nursery Update

As you are aware the school has now been offering provision for nursery aged children since January. This offer is available from 7:45am to 5:30pm every day of the week. This will continue to be, the case regardless of any developments to the currently empty building in the field opposite, previously owned by Caterpillars Nursery.

The current arrangements within our EYFS and KS1 is that children register together and are under the overall leadership of Miss Hannaby and Miss Truswell over the course of the week. However, whilst there may be links, our KS1 children follow a separate to curriculum the children in Reception and Nursery. Those children follow an Early Years Curriculum and usually work and play separately to our KS1 children.

Initial plans for September 2024 are that the provision for our reception and Nursery children will be separate to the children in KS1. Our youngest children will be working within the current EYFS classroom / setting, whilst the current 'middle area' will become a more formalised Year 1 & 2 classroom.

We are currently working with the local authority for additional funding to complete any work required to do this, in addition to turning the old Caterpillars Nursery demountable building into what would essentially be our school hall. This would be used for Daily Worship, indoor PE lessons and school lunches, in addition to other events such as coffee mornings and Christmas Fayres etc.

We are also working on plans to turn the outdoor area by the demountable building in to an EYFS / school garden, which would further enhance the environment at Welshampton.

It is an exciting time to be a Welshampton and we are looking forward to further enhancing our school by welcoming younger children.

To this end, going forward we are offering Stay & Play sessions for Nursery-aged children and their parents.

These sessions will be for both children already at Welshampton and any interested in joining us.

The first Stay & Play session will be at the end of the day on Friday 1st March from 2.15pm to 3.15pm

from Shropshire Beam and Shropshire
Wellbeing Zones Services

Shropshire Beam has been operating with the BeeU partnership in the area since 2017 and over the years we have supported many fantastic children, young people & parents.

Unfortunately, our funding will come to an end in April 2024 and as a result both the Beam and Wellbeing Zone service will close.

Within the past year The Children's Society have had the privilege to work with 1578 young people for individual support and 4607 young people in therapeutic workshops. We recognise the impact this will have in the area once our service closes and are terribly disappointed by the news the funding will not continue.

Our staff have started to notify our children, young people and their families of the closure, with further details to be shared on wider TCS social media accounts. We have also provided links to our website which has a range of resources which will support children, young people and parents whilst identifying other great services across Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin.

There is so much for us to be proud of and we greatly appreciate all Shropshire Beam and Wellbeing Zone teams and would like to thank you for your support over these fabulous years.
