
Message from the Head

Welcome back to school following the Easter break.

Shropshire Council are this week launching a focus on school attendance which supports the work the school has been doing on improving attendance over the last couple of years. This focus has seen attendance rates improve significantly but there is still some work to do.

We value your child's regular school attendance for their academic success. Each day counts towards building your child's educational foundation and attendance significantly impacts academic performance and fosters confidence and belonging.

Your child's consistent attendance is crucial for their success so please communicate any attendance concerns promptly. Attached to this newsletter is a letter from the Local Authority outlining the importance of attendance.



Weekly Attendance

Owl Class – 94%

Hawk Class – 96%

Kestrel Class – 99%

Osprey Class – 85%

Falcon Class – 83%

Average = **91.5%**

This is some way short of our school target which is 97%

Polling Day

As some of you are aware, Polling Day for Police and Crime Commissioners Election is on 2nd May and the school will be used as Polling Station.

<u>The school will remain open</u>, however, as the foyer will be used to house a polling booth, exit and entrance to the school will be via the side gate.

The school has been used for many years as a Polling Station and this will continue as it provides school with a small income.

Wraparound Care and School Club Payments

A reminder that payments for wraparound care at Newtown now need to be made in advance.

Payments can be made either on the School Money app or when a booking is made; we are able to take card payments over the phone or in person. Places can only be reserved once payment has been received by the school.

Those parents who owe money for previous wraparound care provision have been contacted directly as these debts will need to be cleared before future booking can be confirmed.

Newtown Works


We are continually investing in the school and its grounds to improve the environment for the children.
